But although this aesthetic installation pattern has been around for a very long time, it is gaining in popularity again these days. No wonder, because it fits perfectly with modern living:

Openly designed and light-flooded rooms determine the current interior design.

And the trend is also everywhere outside of our own four walls. Whether at trade fairs, in interior design magazines or in interior blogs on the internet, herringbone is more in demand than ever these days.

With MANOR, CLASSEN provides a new interpretation of the classic and gives it a modern and innovative touch. Sixteen modern but timeless wood designs are complemented by the further development of the proven megaloc installation system – megaloc twin – and rounded off by a traditionally inspired name:

MANOR.

Many years of further development of the patented megaloc installation system have resulted in the new megaloc twin. In contrast to conventional herringbone floors, MANOR does not require left and right planks and consists only of A planks.

Another advantage compared to the classic: MANOR can be installed as a floating floor and is therefore more flexible and uncomplicated.

ISOWAXX-TECHNOLOGY

Regardless of the nostalgia that a herringbone floor brings with it, there is one thing you can safely do without: the annoying creaking when you walk across it.

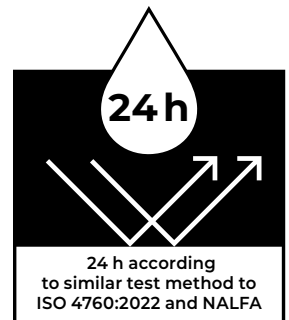
MANOR impresses here with a special technical development:

Isowaxx.

To ensure that each contact point of the floor is waxed on one side, Isowaxx is applied to the long edges as shown in the graphic.

In this way, the long sides - meaning the contact points - where the planks meet, are additionally waxed and thus become more smooth. This means there is hardly any friction between the planks and annoying walking noises are a thing of the past.

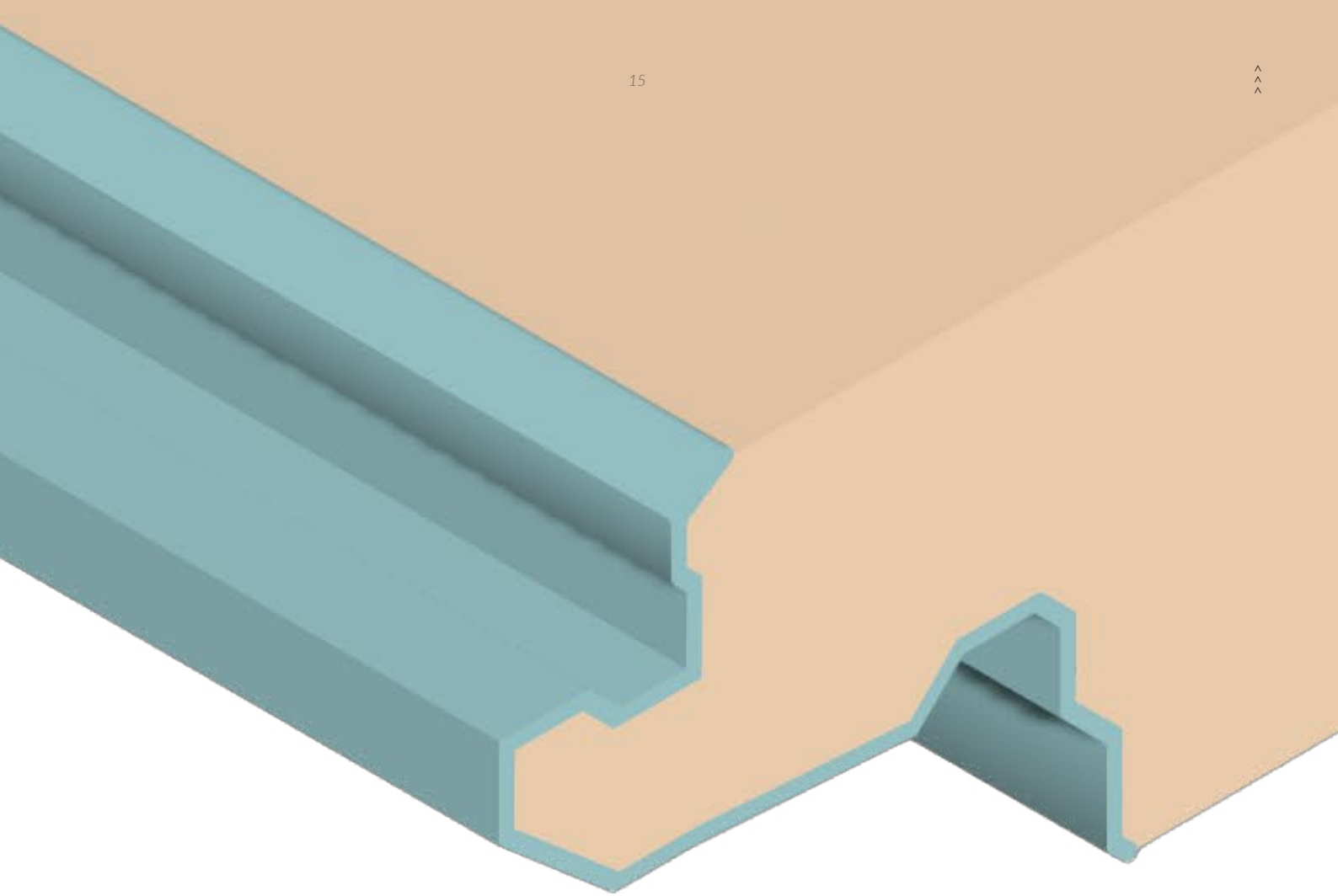




MEGALOC AQUA PROTECT-TECHNOLOGY

Especially when things have to go quickly in everyday life, you don't always think directly about the water on the floor and so the appearance of the floor can quickly be affected. MANOR prevents this with megaloc aqua protect-technology.

The patented profile system, which has been tried and tested for decades, protects the floor up to 24 h from water (based on ISO4760) and reduces the associated swelling of the profile edges. This makes MANOR the perfect partner for minor mishaps in everyday life.

A-A-PLANK-TECHNOLOGY

Where previously double storage or complicated ordering of A-B packages was necessary or there was a risk of possible confusion of planks during installation, megaloc twin - the further development of the already established megaloc installation system - ensures real installation simplicity and rapid progress during installation.

At MANOR, only A planks are used, A and B planks are no longer required. This makes installation uncomplicated and, incidentally, optimises waste.

HOW HERRINGBONE INSTALLATION WORKS TODAY

MANOR is extremely easy to install. Thanks to the fold-down technique, the planks are installed as a floating click system.

The planks are simply joined together at a 20 to 30 degree angle on the long sides and a light pressure with the thumb on the short side locks the stable connection of the planks.



Isowaxx also ensures absolute comfort during installation. Here, the material acts like a glide agent and simplifies the installation of the herringbone planks, as they slide into each other without much effort.

In this way, the risk of overhanging corners is reduced with the result that the longevity of the herringbone floor is extended.

With the detailed installation instructions, installation is quick and easy.

GUIDING THE WAY

If you want to give your home a new look, you can achieve a lot just by the direction in which the floor is installed, as this has a major influence on the atmosphere of the room.

A lengthwise installation gives the room more visual length, a crosswise installation makes the room appear wider and a diagonal installation offers a varied contrast.



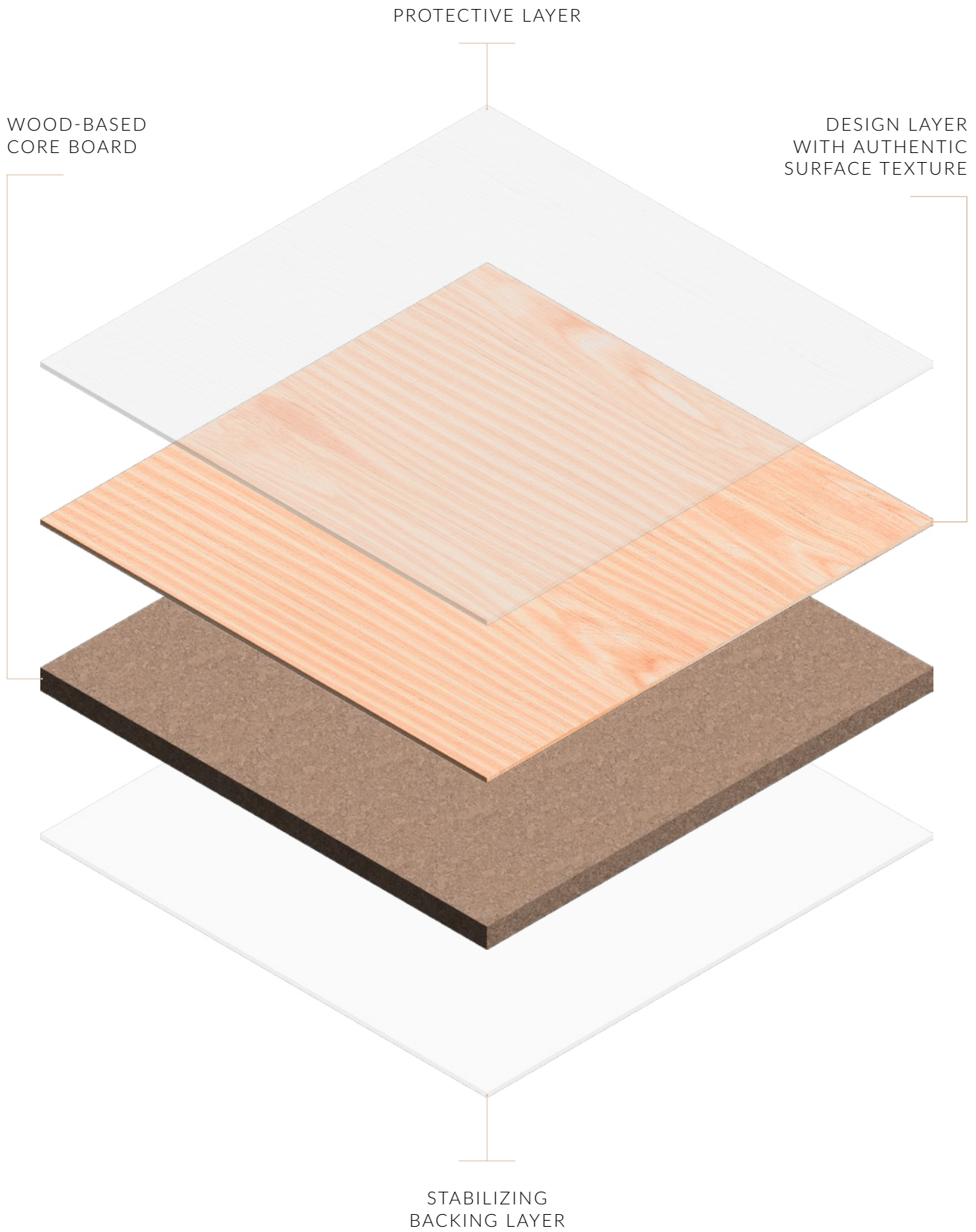


Regardless of which installation direction you choose, all three variants create impressive and elegant effects, because the different directions refract the light differently in the herringbone pattern, giving the room a distinctive character.

As MANOR's production takes place exclusively in Germany and the raw materials come from the local area, we guarantee short transport routes and thus a low CO₂ impact.



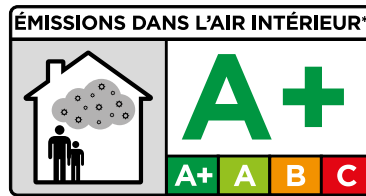
NATURALLY SUSTAINABLE

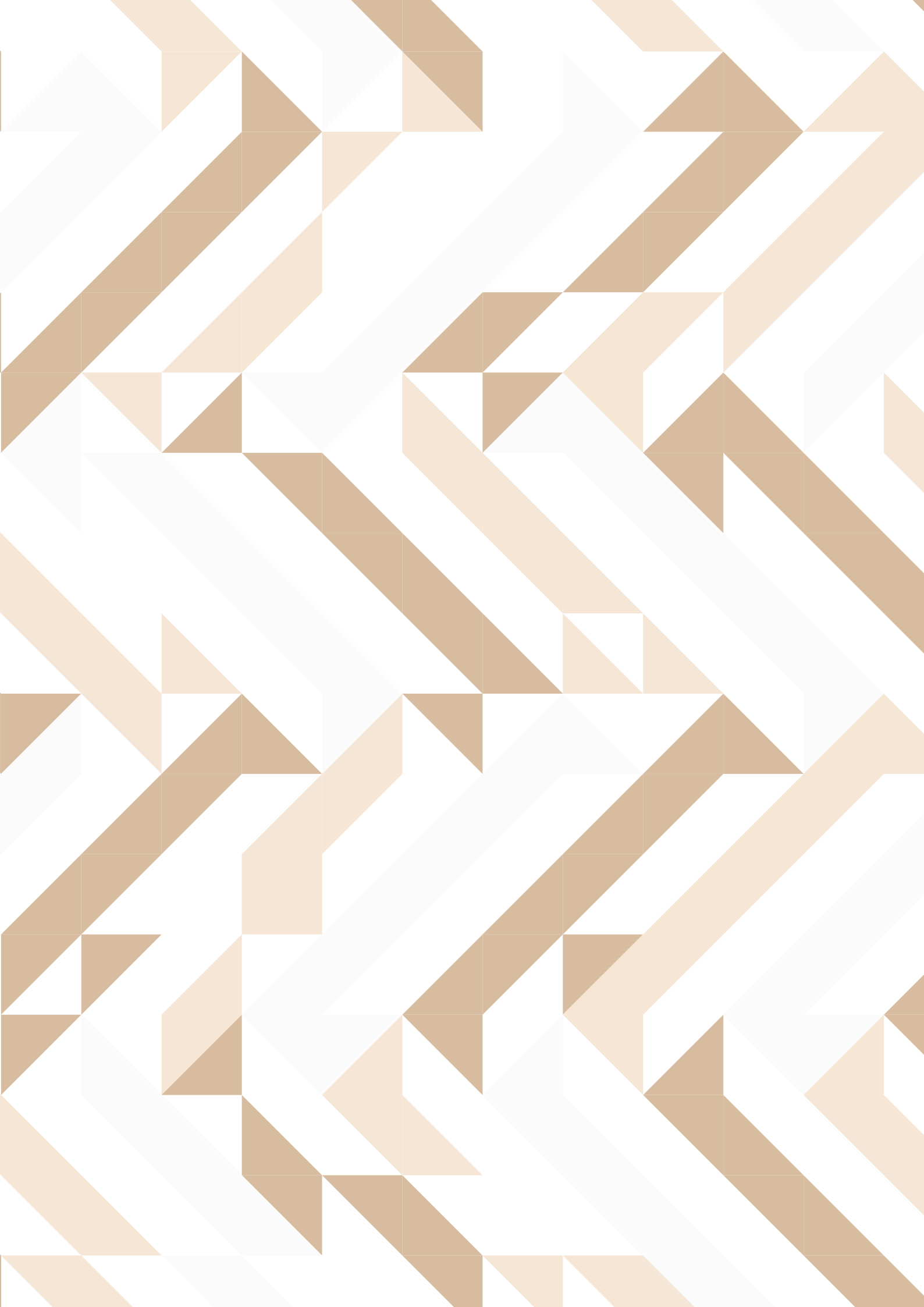
